Leitourgia - Full, active & conscious participation in the Eucharist that informs full, active & conscious prayer life.

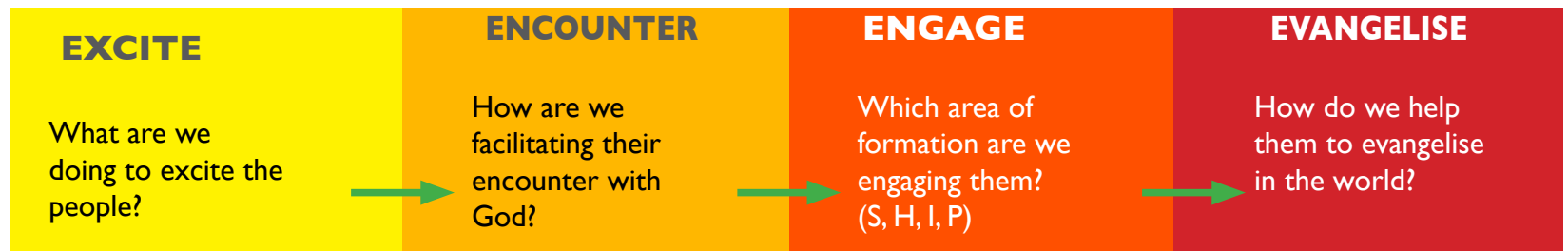
Didache - Learning the Church's teachings and Tradition to become credible witnesses of faith.

4 Areas of Formation

Spiritual: forming a person to live in intimate & unceasing union with the Holy Trinity.

Human: forming a person to be emotionally mature and balanced, with capacity for loving, generous & respectful relationships

Intellectual: equipping a person with knowledge to be a more credible witness of God.

Pastoral: equipping a person to apply human, intellectual & spiritual formation to care and love as God love us.
